Si Burick Scholarship for Youth

Applicants should obtain forms from school guidance counselors. Eligible students must live in Montgomery, Greene, Miami, Butler, Shelby, Darke, Preble or Warren counties and be graduating high school seniors. The winner will receive \$2,000 and the opportunity for paid internships at the Daily News throughout four years of college. Applications must be postmarked by March 31. The internship, called the Mickey Davis Summer Internship, is named for the reporter, editor and columnist for the Journal Herald and Dayton Daily News who died in 1997. "The Si Burick Scholarship and Internship was the most tremendous opportunity I have ever received,"

said Nicholas Hekman, a 2005 graduate of Stivers School for the Arts and the winner of last year's Burick Scholarship.
